Any cash contribution received by 12/31 of \$250 or more will receive a tax letter from United Way, per IRS regulations. Letters will be mailed by 1/31. If you have contributed via payroll deduction, you will not receive a tax letter as your pay stub will serve as tax documentation.

UNITED WAY OF RHODE ISLAND'S COMMUNITY IMPACT FUND

Contributions support people in need through programs and nonprofits that consistently demonstrate results. Through the Community Impact Fund, Rhode Islanders gain the skills they need to achieve financial stability, move from chronic homelessness to stable and affordable housing, receive high-quality educational experiences, and, in the event of a crisis, get connected to essential services through United Way's 211 in Rhode Island.

FUND FOR UNITED WAY 211 IN RHODE ISLAND

Last year, 211 handled more than 194,000 calls from our neighbors in need, demonstrating that when all else fails, people need one single place to turn for help. To this end, we will continue to build the capacity of 211 to receive even more calls each year, helping people access the services that support them when they need help the most.

FUND FOR BASIC NEEDS

The temporary loss of basic supports—shelter, food, utilities, healthcare, or childcare—prevents people from creating stable environments that enable them to work, attend school, care for family, and contribute to the community. Gifts to Basic Needs provide people with help in a temporary crisis, as well as support that provides them the long-term stability to get back on track.

FUND FOR EDUCATION FOR ALL

Investing in educational experiences ranging from high-quality early education to job training for adults is essential for our community. Critical learning opportunities take place throughout our lives, in and out of school. Gifts to Education for All support early childhood education, afterschool programs, and summer programs all designed to make sure that children are ready for college or careers. Gifts to Education for All also support financial literacy and job skill development programs that lead to stable income and employment opportunities for adults.

MyFUND

Because giving is personal, MyFund (a donor-advised fund) consolidates your giving into one easy-to-access account. Give to your alma mater, faith organizations, and all of your favorite charities. Make gifts by payroll deduction, credit card, check, securities, or monthly billing. MyFund allows you to give to any 501(c)(3) in the country, with combined giving of at least \$1,000.

GET INVOLVED

WOMEN UNITED

United Way of Rhode Island's Women United brings women together through philanthropy, volunteerism, and community leadership to help close the gaps in childhood literacy. All members are asked to make an annual gift of \$1,000 or more to United Way's Community Impact Fund or directly to Women United to support programs for childhood literacy.

YOUNG LEADERS CIRCLE (YLC)

YLC is United Way's affinity group for young professionals under age 40. The goal is to engage members in the work of United Way and develop the next generation of philanthropists. No minimum gift is required to join and members are invited to a variety of events including volunteer, professional development, and fundraising opportunities.

Members who give between \$500 and \$999 will receive special recognition as a Skiff Crew member.
